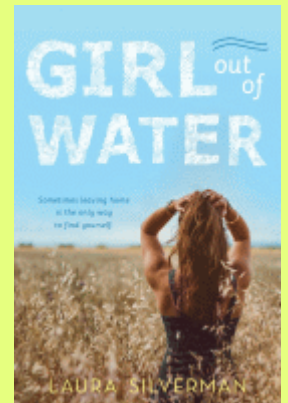

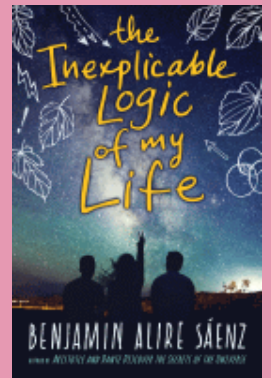


Novel in verse telling the story of a teenage girl facing cyber bullying, first romance, and adolescent angst.

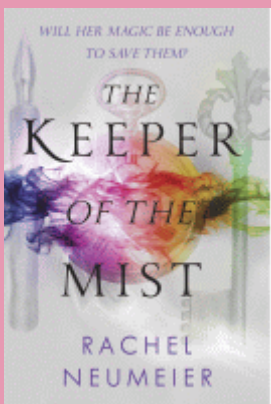

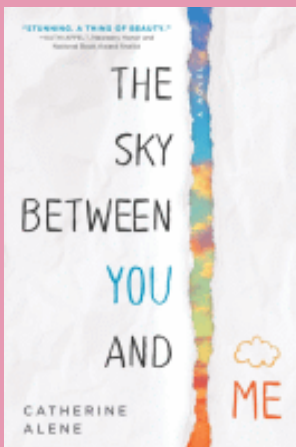


After watching his father being killed by an Epic, a human with super-human powers, David spends his life trying to bring down the Epics, but finds out he does not know all there is to know about them.

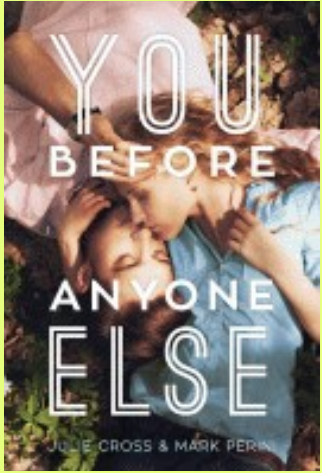
